PAPER PETITION GUIDELINES

Paper petitions <u>must</u> meet these criteria in order to be presented in the House of Commons:

FORMATTING

- 1. At the top of the first page, the petition must state "Petition to [select who the petition is calling upon in the prayer, e.g. the Government of Canada]".
- 2. The prayer of the petition must be indicated on every sheet.
- 3. A petition must be on paper no smaller than 5.5" x 8.5" and no larger than 11" x 17".
- 4. Petitions can be either double-sided or have a blank back page, but cannot be printed on the reverse side of another document.
- 5. Petitions must not be altered by erasing, crossing out, or adding words or commentary.
- 6. No attachments of additional documents or supporting materials are allowed.
- 7. Petitions are only admissible in original hardcopy. No photocopies, scans, e-mails, etc.

SIGNATURES

- 8. A paper petition must contain a minimum of 25 valid signatures.
- 9. A paper petition must have at least 3 of these signatures on the first page of the petition.
- 10. To sign a petition, an individual must either be a citizen or a resident of Canada.
- 11. Each petitioner must sign, not print, their name directly on the petition.
- Each petitioner must write their residential address beside their signature.
- 13. Only original signatures written directly on the document are allowed. Signatures cannot be pasted, taped, photocopied or otherwise transferred to the petition.
- 14. If a petitioner cannot sign because of illness or disability, this must be noted on the petition and the note signed by a witness.

The following guidelines also apply:

- 1. Email addresses and phone numbers are not required.
- 2. There is no minimum age requirement for anyone signing a petition.
- 3. Before mailing the petition to an MP, it is best practice to review all signatures to ensure that at least 25 signatures meet the requirements.
